



I've been very grateful for customer and staff support and loyalty which has fuelled our growth and brand awareness.

What's your favourite product to sell?

There is no particular product that I enjoy selling but I enjoy offering customers coordinated and complementary products to what they originally requested.





WILL start with a quote from Jack Welch (November 19, 1935 – March 1, 2020), former chairman & CEO of General Electric. Fast forward 25 years to two retail locations, five warehouses, two showrooms, and a staff complement of over 100, we remain steadfast in our relentless drive to see this vision through to completion.

From a devaluing dollar, mass migration of local talents, endemics, and a pandemic, to the grandiose entrance of BPOs (which further drained the pool of available local talents), the construction industry was tested beyond its limits to come up with innovative ways to navigate the ever-expanding quagmire of challenges, and only the fittest made it out.

For the near future, I see our projected growth for the period becoming a reality with expansions to our service and a team ready and capable to deliver the shopping experience we are known for. As dominant as our brand is in the industry, it should come as no surprise that I see Home & Things Limited becoming the hub of the Caribbean for all construction finishes.

My wish for the brand is for all invested parties, be they employees, directors, customers, or suppliers, to never lose sight of our vision and to always keep the Home & Things passion to serve, so we will remain the unrivalled leader in the construction industry.
